Award-winning Community Cars

The Community Cars program offers senior citizens personalized curb-to-curb service for needs not currently met by other transportation programs.

Recognized in 2010 with an award for excellence by the Beverly Foundation. Community Cars is a membershipbased transportation program that uses qualified volunteers to drive EZ Ride-branded cars Monday through Friday from 8 am to 4 pm.

Here's what you pay

- \$15 non-refundable annual membership fee (\$25 per couple)
- \$25 refundable security deposit
- \$2.50 per trip each way
- For trips up to 10 miles @ \$1.00/mile
- For trips 10 miles or more @ \$1.25/mile
- There is a 50% discount for shared rides Care-givers may ride for free if their pick-up and drop-off points are the same as the rider's.

Reservations

Reservations must be made at least 48 hours in advance. Earlier reservations ensure availability.

Additional guidelines

- You must be on time for your ride. Your ride may arrive five minutes before or after your appointed time. Drivers are not permitted to wait past your appointed pickup time because they may have other passengers waiting.
- Riders should be able to meet the driver at the car. Small assistive devices, such as a walker. can be accommodated.
- Medical appointments should be made early enough for return trips to be completed by
- Additional stops are considered an extra trip and must be scheduled in advance.
- Late cancellations & No-Show Policy

Late cancellations: No fee is charged if the ride is cancelled by 3pm the day prior to the ride. However, if the ride is cancelled on the same day of the scheduled pick-up, the full trip cost will be billed.

No Show: If the trip is not cancelled and the rider does not show up when the driver arrives for the pickup, \$2 will be charged in addition to the full trip cost.

My husband no longer drives so I had to rely on others to visit my son in Montclair. I would have to pay \$60 for a round trip. Now I rely on Community Cars and only pay a fraction of that.
