Commissioner Boyd reported:

Met with Dieter Lerch regarding the budget for 2010. Did not receive anything back from him as yet, he will be working on it this week and should have it for Tuesday's meeting.

Question regarding the insurance figure on the budget sheets. Believed there was going to be lower figures. Commissioner Poli explained that the figures were received from the insurance company as the figures for the 2010 year.

Commissioner Poli reported:

- 1. Governor Corzine signed into law that EMT certification will go for five years instead of three years. He said that is good and bad as you could let your skills slack a little. He said they will require municipalities to provide EMT service. Perhaps with the contract with Holy Name Hospital we will be covered.
 - 2. He said the deductible for 2010 is \$2500.00 except for sewer back up it is \$1000.00
 - 3. Had a meeting with Bogota, their Mayor and Alan O'Grady. They want us to do their catch basins. Presently they are using our truck. Now we will charge \$250 per hour to cover manpower and our truck. We are not doing the catch basis because of the cost of \$1,000 a day. We will do emergency service during the day. They agreed to share one half of the cost of a truck wash facility. Joseph Monaghan will draw up an interlocal agreement.

Mayor Fosdick reported:

- 1. Stephen Boswell met with the County Administrator and he was asked what the bridge would cost. The attorney said the county is obligated to pay for it. They are interested in a signature bridge. County will not agree to terms which makes them responsible for the bridge if we walk away from it. Mr. Boswell agreed to talk with the Turnpike Authorities. Mayor Fosdick spoke about the background of the bridge.
- 2. Regarding the trees on Main Street, the business owners are concerned that the trees are lifting up the sidewalks. Commissioner Anlian is aware. Mayor Fosdick said the street fair has a go-ahead.
- 3. Spoke about doing an energy audit on the fire hydrants. Asked the Commissioner for approval. All agreed.

Bill Betesh reported:

- 1. Working on Limo licensing ordinance with Captain Rose.. Trying to get something together to introduce.
- 2. Tax appeal on Hilton Hotel. Working out settlement. Mr. Betesh met with our Assessor, Art Carlson on the matter.

Regarding fees for use of parks. Mr. Betesh will revise ordinance before introduction.
