Donated by the 200 Club of Bergen County and Holy Name Hospital, the defibrillator was a part of the club's annual Appropriations Program. Defibrillators are essential to every municipality, as they provide a lifesaving pulse of electricity to restore the heart's normal rhythm after an individual has gone into sudden cardiac arrest. The use of this device could increase the chance of survival from 10 percent to 74 percent. The Corps is very thankful for the donation.
