



EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM NOW ACTIVE IN THE VILLAGE

THE RIDGEFIELD PARK OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND THE VILLAGE EMERGENCY SERVICES NOW HAVE AN EMERGENCY TELEPHONE NOTIFICATION SYSTEM FOR ALL TYPES OF EMERGENCIES.

Coordinator Douglas Hansen and Police Lt. John DiNiro, organizers of the system, have stated, "Many situations exist in which a government agency needs to contact the residents of the community. These situations can vary from school closings to weather emergencies to terrorist threats."



With this system, using a computer in the Municipal Building, the Village can notify all of its residents or all the residents in a specific area, via telephone, of any emergency situation. *The notification of the entire village will take but minutes.*
