**BOARD OF RECREATION

May 18, 2023**

President Diane Maglione called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m., it having been duly noted that this meeting is being held in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq., notice of which was published in The Record and the Star Ledger as well as posted on the Village bulletin board. Roll call was taken. Commission members present: Diane Maglione, Hal Bomzer, Gil Bell, Howie Jacobs, Melinda Lugo, Royce Morris, Mike Ruiz, Barbara Steiner, Bella Wagner. Excused: Melina Pope.

The minutes of the April 20, 2023, meeting were approved on a motion made by Melinda Lugo and seconded by Hal Bomzer. All were in favor of the motion.

Wish Tree – No activity at this time.

Tree Lighting – No activity at this time. Mercedes Haines will write up a set of procedures for Melinda Lugo, who is taking over this event.

Holiday Display Contest – No activity at this time.

Basketball: Early bird registration will be held until August 15. Regular registration will be held on September 22 from 6:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. and September 23 from 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. at the Civic Center. Registration fees in September will be \$55.00. Evaluations will be 10/30 & 11/1.

Saturday Night Hoops – As the All-Star game originally planned was unable to be played, a decision was made to try and hold an All-Star tournament the night of May 20. The Board tried to get set-up straightened out with the DPW so the adult session will start on time. There are 7 adults in this session. Sue has written to the Senior Center to see if they would be interested in holding lessons for the seniors but has not received a response.

In the future, for the program to continue, the instructor needs to arrive earlier so the program can start on time. The Rec table has been damaged by moving it so much. It has footprints on the back of it. Diane said when the instructor arrives after 7:00 p.m., the doors are locked and makes the class even later. Diane comes to open/lock up so a DPW employee is not necessary. She is unavailable on June 18. Mike Ruiz said he can handle it that day.

Easter Egg Hunt – The bunny suit is cleaned and ready for next year.

Treasurer's Report – The beginning balance as of 3/31/23 was \$22,841.00 Total expenses as of 4/28/23 of \$2,922.33 (Sat Night Hoops basketball, rec basketball, Easter candy and prizes, partial ping pong refund, stamps). Total deposits \$1,865.24 (archery and Easter Egg Hunt reimbursement) with \$80.54 interest. Net available balance 4/28/23 \$21,783.91.

A motion was made by Howie Jacobs and seconded by Royce Morris to accept the Treasurer's Report. All were in favor of the motion.

Old Business:

Movie Night – The Board has not received final details on the date and location of movie night yet. Any available members who can help out that night is all that is needed.

New Business:

Earth Day is scheduled for May 20, 2023, from 10:00 am. – 3:00 p.m. at Riverfront Park. The archery clinic will be open, but members are needed to man a table at the event. Melina will be away on business on May 20. DPW will need to put horses by the range so no one walks while shooting is taking place.

Still looking into goat yoga. Howie Jacobs also has some possible new activities he is looking into.

Music program – Amy Bologna will start a summer string music camp. Information will be available shortly.

Dart Program – there was some talk of a possible dart program in the future.

The next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, June 15, 2023.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:59 p.m. on a motion made by Bella Wagner and seconded by Mike Ruiz. All were in favor of the motion.
