# What you need to know about recycling and garbage collection

#### **Aerosol Cans**

Empty & rinse •

#### **Plastic Containers**

#1, #2 or #5 includes beverage, cleaning, and laundry containers

#### **Aluminum Cans & Foil**

Empty & rinse/Discard food waste •

#### **Tin & Steel Cans**

- Empty & rinse
- **Glass Bottle & Jars** 
  - Empty & rinse •



### General household garbage

- Household garbage is picked up at the curb twice a week.
- Place garbage cans at the curb after 5pm the night before scheduled collection.
- Garbage cans must be removed the evening of collection.
- Trash cans **MUST** be 32 gallons or less and weigh no more than 50 lbs.

Cardboard

Flatten boxes --place at curb • Newspapers- NO PLASTIC BAGS!

> Place in a brown paper bag, loosely in a container or tied with string.

Magazines -NO PLASTIC BAGS!

Place in a brown paper bag, loosely in a container or tied with string.

#### **Books**

Remove covers, tie in bundles. •



### **OPEN** → Monday-Saturday 9 am-12 noon

Drop off appliances, batteries, bottles & cans, cardboard, cooking oil, electronics, furniture, lightbulbs, magazines, motor oil, newspapers, EMPTY propane tanks, styrofoam, plastic bags & film, and yard waste.

#### • **Proof of residency required**

NO Commercial or Rental vehicles permitted



#### "White Goods" are picked up at the curb on Wednesday mornings.

- "White Goods" consist of air conditioners, BBQs, computers, dishwashers, dryers, fans, FAX machines, freezers, hot water heaters metal items, monitors, printers, refrigerators, stoves, tires, TVs and washing machines.
- Call 201-440-4860 by Tuesday to schedule a pick-up



Items in good condition & working order may be brought to the recycling center, where other residents can make use of them.

Keep in mind that storage is limitedwe cannot accept upholstered furniture/mattresses/clothing.

ALL items accepted at the discretion of the Recycling Attendant.

## Trash is picked up once a month

- North of Mt Vernon-1<sup>st</sup> Thursday •
- Mt. Vernon & South-1<sup>st</sup> Friday •

Trash includes bags of clothing, furniture, mattresses and toys

- NO HAZARDOUS waste materials will be picked up at the curb.
- Appliances, computers & tires will not be picked up on trash day.



- Yard waste is picked up once a week
  - Mt. Vernon & South-Mondays
  - North of Mt Vernon-Tuesdays
  - Place in cans or paper bags •
  - **NO PLASTIC BAGS!**

#### Leaves may be raked into the street during October, November & December.

Place on the sweeper side of the street on the appropriate day
