Mr. Kelly presented Mr. George Wheatle Williams, Planner, Nishuane Group, LLC, 105 Grove Street, Montclair, NJ to the Board. Mr. Williams was sworn in and presented his qualifications to the Board. Mr. Cathcart accepted Mr. Williams as an expert.
